EU and US Regulatory Challenges Facing AI Health Care Innovator Firms

Although the actual development of a clinically usable, deployable deep-learning algorithm is

a challenge in and of itself, we have moved from an early period where there was not enough guidance as to ethical and other issues to an era where many guidelines have proliferated. AI is being discussed and regulated within Sectoral US laws and EU laws. The fact that they partially overlap, sometimes diverge, and are often written at different levels of generality make it difficult for well-meaning companies to keep up.

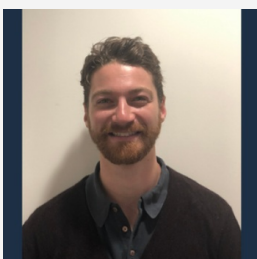
